## On Going and Completed Projects

- We have completed the installation of two jobs in support of a highly recognized Canadian social service institution. Wecon was contracted to supply the equipment and installation at both of these facilities, locally and in Quebec while overseeing the electrical installation of the equipment for both of those sites.
- The mechanical and electrical installation of the order fulfilment system for a new distribution centre in Mississauga for an iconic Canadian clothing retailer continues. We will play a major role in implementing the exciting new technology associated with the project and oversee all phases of the job. Wecon has been contracted to provide service coverage for the site once it has been turned over to the customer.
- Wecon completed the installation of a used lineshaft system including packing tables for the new distribution center for an iconic motor cycle manufacturer / retailer in Brampton. The job was completed ahead of schedule and on budget.
- Scheduled / preventative maintenance continues to be an integral portion of our scope of work. We have several customers who realize the benefit of this service to prevent down time and have contracted us to complete this function as part of a regular routine.
