## On-going and Completed Projects

- We have just completed the installation of a conveyor system for a new retail and distribution center specializing in farm, industrial, automotive, tools and surplus products in Milton. The project consisted of an assortment of both used and new equipment. At the completion of the project Wecon was awarded the decommissioning of the system at their former facility.
- Through one of our business partners, Kuecker Logistic Group we were awarded the installation of a carton flow, shelving and conveyor system they supplied to an ammunitions distribution facility in the Kawartha region of Central Ontario. The customer was extremely pleased with the pace of the installation and execution of the project.
- The installation of a cross dock sortation system comprised of a significant amount of used equipment at a 3PL distributor in Brampton has been completed. The system provides the customer with significant savings in the day to day manpower requirements within their facility. In addition, by incorporating used equipment in conjunction with the implementation of a new sorter they realized they could save a significant amount in the process. A win, win situation for the customer.
- We have been awarded the installation activities associated with a mini load automated storage and retrieval system (AS/RS) and the associated conveyors at a food service distribution facility in Calgary. Our installers are scheduled to commence the installation activities during the month of April.
- We continue to make headway with the installation of several car stacker projects in Metropolitan Toronto. We are waiting for the TSSA to complete and issue their documentation and associated reports pertaining to their findings and observations subject to their inspections at two of the facilities for closure.
- Customers continue to realize the benefits of incorporating used equipment into their projects as it can be supplied in most cases quicker and at a fraction of the cost over new equipment. For those projects on a tight budget, we maintain a large assortment of good quality used equipment available for sale.
