



On-going and Completed Projects

- The installation of a conveyor modification to the packing line has been completed at a hardware manufacturer in Scarborough. The equipment consisted of a series motorized roller conveyors supplied by our business partner TGW Systems.
- We have just completed the installation of a used conveyor system at a discount clothing retailer and distributor in Brampton. The system provides the customer with significant savings in the day to day manpower requirements within their facility. In addition, by incorporating a system comprised of a substantial amount of used equipment they realized they could save a significant amount in the process. A win, win situation for the customer.
- The installation activities associated with a mini load automated storage and retrieval system (AS/RS) and the associated conveyors at a food service distribution facility in Calgary has been completed. Our installers played a major role in co-ordinating the installation and implementation of the mechanical equipment.
