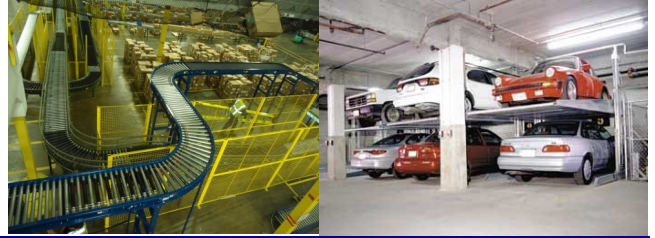
## On-going and Completed Projects

- Our installers are in the final stages of the installation of an Automatic Storage and Retrieval System for the freezer of a major bakery facility for the food service and retail market located in Metropolitan Toronto. Wecon was contracted to provide implementation and installation services that included (5) vertical storage and retrieval machines (SRM's) and the associated transportation conveyors. Final commissioning of the equipment is scheduled to commence shortly.
- We are finally beginning the installation of our first of two car stackers in Toronto. Due to the long extremely cold and snowy winter we experienced, construction activities throughout the city were basically brought to a standstill. With the onset of the good weather, construction activities have begun to flourish putting pressure on Wecon to embark on their installation. Space constraints on the site have proven to be a challenge for our installers who have taken the lead to ensure any further delays are minimized. Installation of the second unit will commence in succession to the completion of the first unit.
- Our installation services have been contracted by a third party logistics provider for yet another e-com provider to decommission a portion of their current system, reconfigure a portion of their existing conveyors and then install a new transportation and sortation system consisting of equipment supplied by one of our business partners TGW-Systems at a retail distribution center in Scarborough. Our veteran installers will oversee installation activities due to the size of the project.
- For those projects on a tight budget we maintain a wide assortment of good quality used equipment that is available for sale. This provides the customer with the option of purchasing used equipment at significant savings over new equipment. Please remember on-hand quantities and used equipment inventories continually change and are subject to sales volumes. Contact us for details and equipment availability.
