On Going and Completed Projects

- The mechanical and electrical installation of the order fulfillment system for a new distribution centre in Mississauga for an iconic Canadian clothing retailer is in its final stages. Wecon played a major role in implementing the exciting new technology associated with this project and oversaw all phases of the job. Wecon has been contracted to provide service coverage for the site once it has been turned over to the customer.
- The final stages of commissioning at a major cosmetic distribution facility in Mississauga is complete and the project has been turned over to the customer. Wecon was contracted to provide the mechanical and electrical upgrades to the customer's existing system which was previously installed by us. These improvements were made in support of increased volumes experienced by the customer.
- We have been contracted to provide major upgrades and modifications to the existing pack line for their put to store distribution system at a distribution & clothing distributor in Cambridge. The original job was previously supplied and installed by Wecon. Wecon will coordinate all facets and oversee all phases of the job.
- We have completed the decommissioning of a 3PL distribution warehouse in Brampton. Wecon will be utilized to repurpose this equipment at the customer's new facilities.
- We were just awarded the contract to supply the equipment for a major health care provider for their picking and distribution system at their warehousing and distributing center in Calgary. This project was awarded to us based on price and past performance with a local distributor.
- We still maintain a large assortment of good quality used equipment available for sale at tremendous savings. Included in this used equipment inventory is a significant amount of used 24" and 36" nominal width lineshaft, 30" nominal width sliderbed conveyors and a diminishing amount of 18" wide nominal width 1.9" gravity conveyors on 4" centers. Customers continue to realize the benefits of incorporating used equipment into their projects as it can be supplied in most cases quicker and at significant cost savings over the cost of new equipment.
