What's Happening At Wecon Services On Going and Completed Projects

- Manufacturing is complete and installation is scheduled for mid April for a new Military Airplane cargo handling system in Eastern Ontario.
 - A new DC for photography equipment is ready for start up; we were also able to fulfill all the system requirements with in stock refurbished equipment, saving time and money.
 - An automotive parts supplier in South Western Ontario continues to find ways to improve their material handling with equipment that we are always able to supply them with.
 - The first of many units is ready to be delivered to an Ontario University technology center, this very specialized application will be used for a National energy program, specifically a Uranium pellet loading system.
 - Phase two is already running at a fruit and vegetable growers facility in Southwestern Ontario.
 - Plans are under way to install a new automatic in-motion weigh scale into a system installed last year for a Toronto cosmetics company.
 - The installation of phase one is complete and the new pallet handling automatic transfer car is delivering pallets of margarine from the first couple of automatic palletizers to the automatic truck loading system as planned.
 - All the planning is over and manufacturing has begun for a new 30 lane high speed sortation system to handle retail goods, installation of this new system is scheduled for late spring, watch for more information on this project in the near future.


