- We are in the final stages of the installation and commissioning of an Automatic Storage and Retrieval System for the freezer of a major bakery facility for the food service and retail market located in Metropolitan Toronto. Wecon was contracted to provide implementation and installation services that included (5) 60 ft high vertical storage and retrieval machines (SRM's) and the associated transportation conveyors.
- The decommissioning, reconfiguring and installation of a new transportation and sortation system at a retail distribution center in Scarborough continues.
